LATAH CREEK'S WHITES

Their white wines continue to be some of the best in the state. Mike Conway's winemaking style brought instant success with wines from his first vintage of 1982 that many saw Best of Show winners – a feat never before done. His achievement was immediate, making him one of the forefront winemakers in Washington State. The success has continued for Latah Creek and their whites. In 2014 alone, Latah Creek received 2 Best of Class awards, 5 Double Gold medals, and 4 Gold medals for various whites.

LATAH CREEK'S REDS

Their red wines are wonderfully fruity varieties that are utterly delicious by themselves, to big, bold, and tannic reserve reds that really shine when accompanying a meal. All are marvelous to drink right now, but don't hesitate to cellar a few for 5-10 years for a real treat. They still make their award-winning Merlot, but have been able to put their food-friendly/easy drinkability winemaking techniques to various trend varieties, their favorites being Sangiovese and Malbec.

8 WINE TASTING + TASTE TEST THEIR SPECIAL LIBRARY RESERVE

OWNER AND WINEMAKER, MIKE CONWAY, WILL DISCUSS EACH OF THE WINES AS WE TASTE THEM

1	Latah Creek Chardonnay 2018	Aromas of lemon, golden apple and butter. The rich and creamy mouthfeel begins with flavors of mango and pineapple, mingled with soft oak, while lemon and mineral nuances linger. A nearly complete malolactic fermentation and 3 months in French oak lends to a smooth, velvety, and lightly toasted finish.
2	Latah Creek Pinot Gris 2021	Our award-winning Pinot Gris is consistently one of the best in the state. Aromas of tropical fruit greet your senses immediately. Once on your tongue, this off-dry wine bursts with flavors of papaya and lime, with ginger and grapefruit following. The vividly crisp and refreshing finish leaves you wanting more.
3	Latah Creek Rosé of Malbec 2021	Aromas of ripe red berries, watermelon, and rose hips. This well-structured wine begins on the tongue with flavors of melon, raspberries, and mineral, while ending with black cherry nuances and a crisp ruby red grapefruit.
4	Latah Creek Riesling 2020	Aroma of honeysuckle and fresh pear. Flavors of golden pear and citrus blossom immediately greet your tongue, while golden delicious apple and a sweet minerality lingers on.
5	Latah Creek Mike's Reserve Red #3	These 4 wines blend together beautifully, creating lush, intensely fruity, full-bodied red. Ripe red grapes, purple flowers, and toasted oak on the nose. Dried plum, blackberry, and soft fine leather upon first sip, while espresso and dark chocolate linger.
6	Latah Creek Reserve Mourvèdre 2018	This gorgeous ruby-colored wine engulfs all senses with aromas and flavors of plum, black currant, toasted oak, and violets. Left lingering on your tongue long after the wine is swallowed are flavors of blueberry mingled with hints of black pepper and fine leather.
7	Latah Creek Tempranillo 2018	Natalie's favorite red varietal begins with an intensely ruby-red-color, then opens up with aromas of grapes, sweet flowers, and fine leather. Upon first sip, your mouth is engulfed with fig and dark cherry, while toasted vanilla bean lingers long after the wine is swallowed.
8	Latah Creek Malbec 2018	This deep-purple-colored wine begins with aromas of black cherry and raisin. Wonderful bright plum, blueberry, and tobacco flavors mingle while hints of dark roasted coffee and pomegranate seem to linger on forever.
	Special Reserve Library Wine	Full-bodied, rich tannins, higher alcohol – absolutely delectable. Frosting on the cake if offered!
